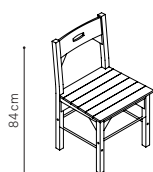
Along with the Cartesio bookcase, the Museo chair was also designed by Aldo Rossi in 1994 for the Bonnefanten Museum in Maastricht as a special project for the museum coffee shop.

Available with or without arms, Museo is an essential wooden chair. Special characteristics include the use of American cherry wood and striking accents created by the deep yellow hue of the triangular reinforcing elements and dowel-shaped rungs. Holes in the side reinforcing elements permit the chairs to be linked together for various uses.

Its classic, timeless form, allows the Museo chair, originally designed to accommodate visitors in need of a refreshing break during their tour of the museum, to fluidly fit into corporate and domestic ambiances.

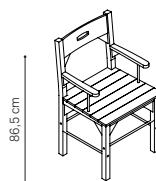


Chair



Without armrests

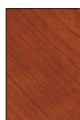
